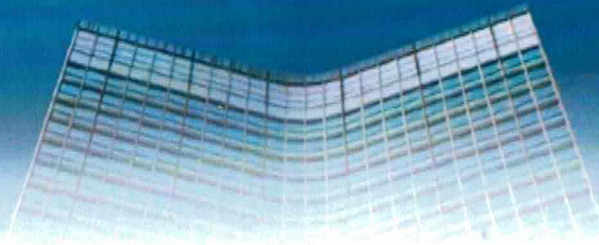


MILLBANK TOWER

The Millbank Complex with its famous 33 storey tower sits on the north bank of the River Thames and has been a London landmark since its construction in 1959. In order to future proof the Grade II Listed buildings and secure their future as a heritage asset the owners propose to invest in extensive remedial works to the exterior and interior of the building, and will take this opportunity to introduce exciting new proposals to the site. The scheme will include.

- A public arts and cultural centre to add to the heritage destination on the north bank
- A residential offer of around 200 apartments provided by remodelling of the existing commercial floor space
- Extended amenity space for residents and hotel users with potentially some access for local residents
- A new Sky Bar at the top of the tower with views over the River Thames
- A hotel and leisure complex with swimming pool, gym and wellness centre
- Two new restaurants

Initial pre-application discussions have been held with officers and councillors at Westminster Council, and Millbank Tower Ltd hope to lodge a planning application in August. Ahead of this they now wish to give the local community the opportunity to view the proposals and have their say. We do hope you will be able to attend. During the exhibition representatives of the consultant team will be on hand to answer any questions you may have.
